**What's required to become an AYSO coach?** If you're willing to contribute your time and effort to ensuring that kids have a fun experience in a fair and safe program, then you possess the necessary prerequisites to become an AYSO coach. Regardless of whether or not you know a lot about soccer, AYSO will provide the training and tools to help you become a good coach. We've had plenty of moms and dads that started out knowing little about soccer that have gone on to become terrific coaches!

However, in order to become an AYSO coach it is **required** that you get the appropriate training. Also, please be aware that it is mandatory that all coaches take the Safe Haven course prior to coaching, and to have a current Volunteer form on file.

Safe Haven course – All AYSO coaches need to be Safe Haven certified – 2 options – at Ladendorf Park

- Saturday August 7 - 9:30 to 11:30 am
- Saturday August 28 - 9:30 to 11:30 am

U-6 Course – for coaches of Kindergarten teams – 2 options – at Crowley Park

- Thursday July 22 - 6:30 to 8:30 pm
- Tuesday Aug 24 - 6:30 to 8:30 pm

U-8 Course – for coaches of 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade teams – 2 options – at Crowley Park

- Monday July 26 - 6:30 to 8:30 pm
- Thursday Aug 26 - 6:30 to 8:30 pm

U-10 Course – for coaches of 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Grade teams – 2 options – at Ladendorf Park

- Saturday August 7 - Noon to 3:00 pm
- Saturday August 28 - Noon to 3:00 pm

U-12 Course – for coaches of 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Grade teams – 2 options – at Ladendorf Park

- Saturday August 7 - Noon to 5:00 pm
- Saturday August 28 - Noon to 5:00 pm

All AYSO coaches are required to take Safe Haven training. However, if you have already taken the Safe Haven training once, it is not required that you take it again. If you are attending the U-6, U-8, U-10, or U-12 course, please bring a soccer ball and come dressed ready to play soccer. All courses will be at Crowley Park (formerly Huber Park) – 749 Huber Lane (park is located south of Glenview Road at the end of Huber between Greenwood and Shermer), OR Ladendorf Park – 2541 Harrison Street (on Harrison and Floral between Shermer and Washington).
