

To our Glenview AYSO community:

As of the last update 3/8/2021 Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) mandates that ALL athletes, coaches, referees and spectators wear masks at all times for youth sports.

The Sports Safety Guidance pertains to all youth and adult recreational sports, including, but not limited to, school-based sports (high school and elementary school), travel clubs, private leagues and clubs, recreational leagues and centers, and park district sports programs. This guidance does NOT pertain to professional sports leagues or college division level sports. This guidance supersedes all previously issued All Sports Guidance issued from DCEO, IDPH and /or ISBE.

The guidelines have been in flux and this regulation differs from our earlier correspondence and our fall season protocols. They are subject to change and we will keep you apprised if/when they do.

The Glenview Park District, as well as neighboring park districts and other privately run athletics, are currently operating under these guidelines and therefore many players may be accustomed to wearing their masks for exercise. We understand that this may be a difficult adjustment for others.

Masks are required for all participants and spectators.

We appreciate the cooperation of all of our participants. Please treat your volunteer coaches and referees with kindness and respect and follow the guidelines.
